

Job Posting: Student Position Camp Logistics Crew: Summer Camp 2026

Join our Summer Camp 2026 team as a **Camp Logistics Crew**, where you'll be an essential part of the team ensuring camp runs smoothly. Working under the direction of the Logistics Supervisor, your role is to support all aspects of camp logistics, from set-up and take-down to assisting in the transportation and organization of supplies and equipment. Your day may include helping with supply shopping and deliveries, assisting with activity and program set-up, cleaning and organizing camp spaces or parks, and supporting the logistics crew in any way needed to keep camp operations running efficiently. This role requires a proactive, hands-on approach, physical stamina, and the ability to follow direction while working closely with others.

Requirements & Qualifications:

- Valid G2 license
- Access to a vehicle (asset)
- Ability to lift, carry, and transport supplies and equipment
- Strong teamwork and communication skills
- Willingness to perform physical, hands-on work in outdoor settings
- Dependable, proactive, and solution-focused attitude

Wages for Crew:

- \$600-\$720 per week

Education/Certifications:

- You must be a student (students must be returning to school in the fall)
- Standard First Aid & CPR C in good standing during summer season
- HIGH FIVE: Principles of Healthy Child Development certification
- Vulnerable Sector Police Records Check (within 6 months) for those 18 years of age and older

Scheduling:

- Must commit to working Monday-Fridays, flexible shifts starting at 7:00am or ending at 6:00pm

- All-Staff Training 1 of 2: Saturday, June 6, all day
- All Staff Training 2 of 2: Saturday, June 20, all day
